

***New Testament Bible Study***

\*Pastor Kevin's Meditations & Contemplations for Week Twenty-Three

- (June 5 - 2 Corinthians 7) "So having these promises, beloved ones, let us purify ourselves from every pollution of flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in fear of God (2 Corinthians 7:1).": From what do you need to be purified? How do you characterize the holiness to which you are going on to perfection?
  
- (June 6 - 2 Corinthians 8) "At the present juncture, your abundance is for their lack, so that their abundance may be for your lack, in order that there might be equality...(2 Corinthians 8:14).": Why is equality so very important?
  
- (June 7 - 2 Corinthians 9) "Being enriched in everything for the purpose of all generosity, which brings about thanksgiving from us to God (2 Corinthians 9:11).": What generosity do you need to offer from your enriching?
  
- (June 8 - 2 Corinthians 10) "For the weapons of our campaign are not fleshly, and yet are (through God) powerful enough to overthrow fortresses—we who are overthrowing argumentations, and taking every concept captive for subjection to the Anointed...(2 Corinthians 10:4, 5).": What are weapons through God?
  
- (June 9 - 2 Corinthians 11) "If I must boast, I will boast of things belonging to my weakness (2 Corinthians 11:10).": Why is boasting to be done from the standpoint of weakness?
  
- (June 10 - 2 Corinthians 12) "I knew a man who is in the Anointed, one such as was rapt up all the way into the third heaven fourteen years ago—whether in

the body I do not know, whether out of the body I do not know—the Lord knows (2 Corinthians 12:2).”: How far is heaven?

- (June 11 - 2 Corinthians 13) “Greet one another with a holy kiss (2 Corinthians 13:12).”: Are you interested in restarting this practice of the 1st Century Church?

- (June 12 - Galatians 1) “[Lord Jesus the Anointed] Who has given Himself on behalf of our sins so that He might deliver us from the present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father, to Whom be the glory unto the ages of the ages; amen (Galatians 1:4, 5).”: *Why did Jesus give Himself on behalf of our sins?*
- (June 13 - Galatians 2) “And who know that a human being is vindicated not by observances of Law but by the faithfulness of the Anointed One Jesus—even we have placed our faith in the Anointed One Jesus, so that we might be vindicated from the faithfulness of the Anointed and not from observances of Law, because no flesh at all will be vindicated from observances of Law (Galatians 2:16).”: *If no flesh at all will be vindicated from observances of Law, then why have so many people held onto rule-keeping as the means for salvation?*
- (June 14 - Galatians 3) “Thus the Law has become our custodial guide to the Anointed, so that we might be proved righteous from faithfulness; but, the faith having come, we are no longer under a custodial guide (Galatians 3:24, 25).”: *What are the roles of both the Law and faith as each pertains to salvation and holiness, respectively?*

- (June 15 - Galatians 4) Hence, brothers [& sisters], we are not the maidservant's children, but the freewoman's (Galatians 4:31).": *Who is the maidservant, who is the freewoman, and what does this have to do with salvation and the Christian life?*
  
- (June 16 - Galatians 5) "The Anointed freed us for freedom; stand fast, then, and do not again be restrained by slavery's yoke (Galatians 5:1).": *What is the freedom for which Christ has set His brothers and sisters free?*
  
- (June 17 - Galatians 6) "May I, however, boast in nothing except the cross of our Lord Jesus the Anointed, through Whom the cosmos has been crucified to me and I to the cosmos (Galatians 6:14).": *What does it mean to boast in the cross?*
  
- (June 18 - Ephesians 1) "The eyes of your heart having been illumined, so that you should know what the hope in His call is, what the riches of His glory's inheritance in the holy ones, and what the extravagant glory of His power toward us who have faith, in accord with the operation of the strength of His might, which He has enacted in the Anointed, raising Him from the dead and seating Him at His right hand in the heavenly places... (Ephesians 1:18-20).": *Why does Paul say the eyes of our hearts have been illumined?*
